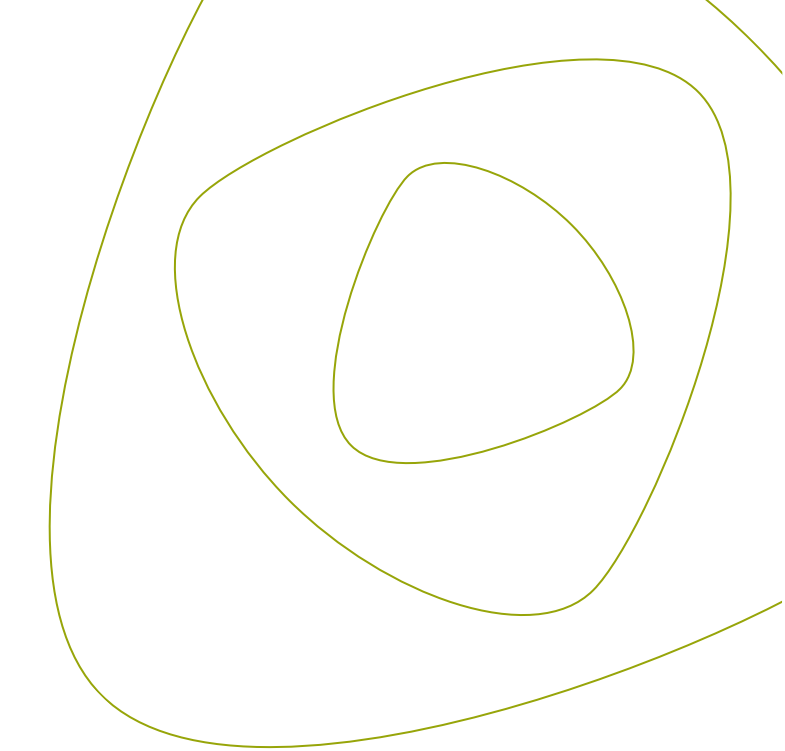

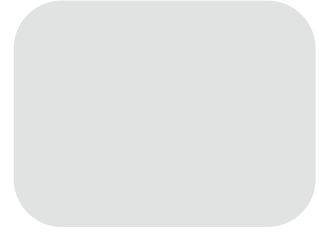
Why mediation?
